

## **Family Fall Fun Adventure Tour 1**

Do some trap shooting at Mantrap Shooting Preserve

Canoe or Tube the Crow Wing - Canoes, kayaks and all the gear available for rent from Huntersville Outfitters and rent your tubes at Huntersville Outpost.

Canoe, Bike or Pontoon at Itasca State Park on Lake Itasca or down the Mississippi River - sporting equipment rentals available from Itasca Sports Rental at Itasca State Park or check with R&R Rental.

Trout Fishing-Straight River

Lake or Pier Fish from one of our public fishing piers or accesses

Fall Colors Leaf Watching - Itasca State Park offers this as well as the opportunity to walk across the Mississippi Headwaters and visit the Jacob V. Brower Visitor Center open year round with great interactive activities for kids.

Or view fall colors along Hwy 34 West along the Lake Country Scenic Byway to the Tamarac National Wildlife Refuge for a nature hike

Bike the Heartland Trail for anywhere from 6 to 49 miles - Bike rentals at Heartland Trail Bed & Breakfast, Dorset or Muskie Waters in Nevis. Distance enthusiasts can connect with the Paul Bunyan Trail at the Hubbard-Cass County line for a trip all the way to Baxter/Brainerd along an extended 71 miles.

Play golf several courses or miniature golf at Evergreen Park at World of Christmas. (Or stay at a PR lodging facility Sept. 12-20, Chamber Lodging Fall Golf Week, and receive a discount at 6 different courses.)

Take in the Northland Bison Ranch Tour and view buffalo in their own habitat.

Visit the Evergreen Park Family Fun Center at World of Christmas for miniature golf, a train ride, miniature go cart tracks or rock wall climbing. A light lunch and great fudge await you.
